Born in Tehran in 1972, at the age of 12 Ms. Mazahery immigrated to the U.S. She is the founder and president of the Legal Rights Institute, and one of the critics of Former Iranian President Mohammad Khatami, accusing him of many crimes against humanity during his term. Ms. Mazahery is an active advocate of the human rights of women around the world and an outspoken opponent of laws that serve to oppress women in the name of religion. She has testified before the U.S. Congress on the condition of women in Iran and has described the atrocities to which women are subjected. She appeared on 60 Minutes in early October.
